POLICE IMPERSONATOR CHARGED

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has charged a man accused of impersonating a peace officer.

Darrick Huhman (dob: 11-16-82) is charged with one count of *impersonating a peace officer* (F6) and one count of *possession or use of a red or blue lights* (M1).

The charges allege that on Jun 23, 2008, Huhman was driving a vehicle with red and blue flashing lights and pulled over another vehicle near Chambers Road and Andrews Drive. The charges further allege Huhman fled the scene when he approached the other driver and saw that he was a Denver Sheriff Deputy. He was located near I-70 and Chambers Road a short time later by Denver police.

Huhman has been released from custody on a \$2000 bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on July 8, 2008 to be formally advised of the charges.
