MAN CHARGED WITH INTERNET LURING OF A CHILD

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of trying to arrange a sexual encounter with an underage juvenile female.

Taylor Matthew Singleton (dob: 12-18-81) is charged with multiple felony counts including Internet sexual exploitation of a child (F4), Internet luring of a child with intent to exploit (F4), enticement of a child (F4), and attempted sexual assault on a child (F5).

The charges allege that Singleton used an online chat room to contact someone he believed to be a female under 15 years of age and arranged to meet this person with the intent of engaging in sexual contact. He was taken into custody by Denver police officers on June 16, 2008 when he arrived at a Denver park. The "girl" was an undercover Denver police detective posing as an underage female.

Singleton has been released from custody on a \$10,000 bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on August 1, 2008, at 9 a.m. to be advised of the charges against him.
