MAN CHARGED IN BOOKSTORE ASSAULT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of fondling a young girl in a Denver bookstore last weekend.

Ian Troutman (dob: 04-05-81) is charged with *sexual assault on a child* (F4) and *enticement of a child* (F3).

The charges allege that on January 20, 2008, he grabbed a 7-year-old girl in a downtown bookstore and assaulted her in a secluded area of the store. Denver police identified Troutman as a suspect and arrested him in front of the store as he was leaving.

Troutman remains in custody in the Denver County Jail; his bond is set at \$250,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on January 28, 2008, at 9 a.m. to be advised of the charges.
