TWO JUVENILES CHARGED AS ADULTS IN DOUBLE MURDER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged two juveniles as adults in connection with a double shooting last Monday June 22, 2009.

Saul Anaya (dob: 03-28-92) is charged with two counts of *murder in the first-degree* (F1), one count of *attempted murder in the first-degree* (F2), one count of *illegal discharge of a weapon* (F5), one count of *possession of a handgun by a juvenile* (M2), and one count of a *crime of violence* (SE).

Bryan Segovia (dob: 03-07-93) is charged three counts of *conspiracy to commit murder in the first-degree* (F2).

On June 22, 2009, at about 3 a.m., Denver Police officers responded to 9600 E. Girard Avenue on a report of a shooting. The charges allege that Anaya fired at three young men with whom he had been involved in an earlier altercation, killing two of them. The charges further allege that Segovia was part of carrying out the attack.

Anaya and Segovia remain in custody and will be transferred to the Denver County Jail. They are scheduled to appear in Denver District Courtroom 17 on Monday, June 29, 2009 at 8:30 a.m. for their first advisement.
