CHARGE FILED IN CONVENIENCE STORE MURDER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused in the May 2, 2009 murder of a convenience store clerk.

Dale Baylis (dob: 01-13-63) is charged with first-degree murder (F1).

The charge alleges that Baylis entered a convenience store at 567 E. Louisiana Avenue in the early morning hours of May 2, 2009 and shot and killed 28-year-old Natnael Mulugeta.

Baylis was identified as a suspect and taken into custody on May 6, 2009. He remains in the Denver County Jail and is being held without bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on May 15, 2009 at 9 a.m. to be advised of the charge.
