### **CHARGES FILED IN DOMESTIC VIOLENCE/RESISTING ARREST CASE**

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has charged a man with multiple felony counts for his role in a domestic violence and resisting arrest incident that resulted in injuries to three Denver police officers.

**Leroy Delphie** (dob: 07-07-84) is charged with three counts of *criminal mischief* (F4), *second-degree assault* (F4), *vehicular assault* (F5), three counts of *menacing* (F5), *assault in the third degree* (M1) and *child abuse* (M2).

On September 26, 2009 at about 7 p.m., Denver police responded to the area of 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Perry Street to investigate a domestic violence report. The charges allege that Delphie tried to flee the scene, tried to ram the officers with his car, and after abandoning the car he fought with officers while they were taking him into custody.

Delphie remains in custody in the Denver County Jail; his bond is set at \$100,000. He is scheduled to be formally advised of the charges in Denver County Court, room 12T, on October 2, 2009 at 9 a.m.
