CHICAGO-AREA MAN CHARGED WITH INTERNET LURING

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a Chicago-area businessman with multiple counts of Internet sexual exploitation of a child. The charges were filed yesterday in Denver District Court.

Kenneth Goldman (dob: 08-11-67) is charged with nine counts of *Internet sexual exploitation of a child* (F), four counts of *obscenity* (F6) and *attempted Internet luring of a child* (F).*

The charges allege that between May and July 2008 Goldman contacted someone online that he believed to be a 14-year-old girl and engaged in highly sexualized conversation, shared obscene material and wanted to meet her.

Goldman was extradited to Colorado on January 28, 2009, by the Douglas County Sheriff's Office, where he is facing a similar case. He has been released from custody after posting a \$50,000 bond in the Denver case and a \$25,000 bond in the Douglas County case.

He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on February 13, 2009 at 9 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges, and is scheduled to appear in Douglas County Court, Division B, on April 23, 2009 at 1:30 p.m. for a preliminary hearing.
