THREE CHARGED IN SHOOTING THAT LEFT DAD AND BABY HURT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged three people in connection with a shooting that occurred January 25, 2009 in the 12000 block of East Albrook Drive.

Lonnell Pyles (dob: 01-02-85) and **Daswjaun Goode** (dob: 12-29-87) are each charged with *attempted first-degree murder* (F2), *first-degree assault* (F3) two counts of *aggravated robbery* (F4) and *menacing* (F5).

Tredon Davis (dob: 05-25-92) is charged as an adult with *attempted first-degree murder* (F2), *first-degree assault* (F3), and *attempted aggravated robbery* (F4).

The charges allege that all three entered the victim's home on January 25, 2009 and an altercation ensued that resulted in shots being fired. A 31-year-old man and an 8-month-old baby were injured.

Pyles and Goode remain in custody in the Denver County Jail; bond is set at \$75,000 each. They are scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on February 4, 2009 at 9 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.

Davis was advised of the charges earlier today and is scheduled to appear in Denver District Courtroom 17 on February 4, 2009 at 8:30 for entry of appearance by counsel. He remains in custody in the Denver County Jail; his bond is set at \$250,000.
