TWO CHARGED IN DECEMBER 30th MURDER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged two men in connection with the December 30, 2008 shooting death of 25-year-old Kenneth Espinoza and the wounding of 28-year-old Phillip Baca.

Quinn Guytan (07-06-86) is charged with first-degree murder (F1) and attempted first-degree murder (F2).

Paul Anthony Meza (04-21-78) is charged with two counts of being an accessory to crime (F4).

The charges allege that Guytan was involved in an altercation with the two victims and shot them in the area of the 900 block of west 9th Avenue and that Meza was an accessory.

Guytan and Meza remain in custody in the Denver County Jail. They are scheduled to appear in Denver County Court on January 14, 2009 at 9 a.m. to be advised of the charges.
