WOMAN CHARGED IN MAN'S MURDER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a woman accused in the murder of a 35-year-old man whose body was found in a recycling waste just more than a week ago.

Theresa Harris (dob: 12-09-64) is charged with *first-degree murder* (F1).

The charges allege that Harris stabbed the victim, Charles Hardy, sometime late on December 12, 2009 or early on December 13, 2009 in the 2200 block alley between Clarkson and Emerson Street.

Harris remains in custody in the Denver County Jail; she is being held without bond. Harris is scheduled to appear in Denver District Court, room 472W, on Tuesday, December 29, 2009 at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
