GUILTY PLEAS IN DEATH OF 10-YEAR OLD GIRL

All three young men accused of felony murder in the shooting death of 10-year-old Auralia Cisneros in November 2007 have now entered guilty pleas in the case, and one of the three was sentenced today.

21-year-old **Juvencio Hernandez** (dob: 01-14-88) was sentenced to 16 years in prison today for an earlier guilty plea to second-degree murder (F2).

20-year-old **Joshua Rojas** (dob: 11-03-88) pleaded guilty yesterday to second-degree murder (F2) and faces up to 30 years in prison when he sentenced on August 20, 2009.

21-year-old **Trivi Trujillo** (dob: 04-16-88) pleaded guilty in April to second-degree murder and faces up to 26 years in prison when he sentenced on September 3, 2009.

Hernandez, Rojas and Trujillo were accused of trying to commit a robbery at the Cisneros home on November 26, 2007 when they exchanged gunfire with someone inside the home. Auralia Cisneros died after being hit by a gunshot.

Leo Cisneros is facing trial in August in connection with his daughter's death.
