GRAND JURY RETURNS 78-COUNT INDICTMENT IN AUTO DEALER SCAM

A Denver Grand Jury has returned a 78-count indictment accusing a Castle Rock auto dealer of theft and fraud.

Wayne Dwight Weaver, Jr. (DOB: 09/10/61) is charged by indictment with 24 counts of *defrauding a secured creditor* (F3 and F5) and 54 counts of *theft* (F3 and F4).

The indictment alleges that Weaver, the manager and co-owner of Castle Pines Auto Sport located in Castle Rock, Colorado, defrauded his customers and lenders. The theft is alleged to be in excess of 1.3 million dollars and involves numerous individual customers and metro area lenders.

The indictment was unsealed by the Denver District Court on January 6, 2009. An arrest warrant has been issued for Wayne Dwight Weaver, Jr. (DOB: 09/10/61), who remains at large. Weaver's bond is set at \$500,000.

The complex investigation, headed by the Denver District Attorney's Office Economic Crime Unit in conjunction with the Colorado Department of Revenue's Auto Industry Division, involved more than 150 vehicles and over 1.3 million dollars of losses.
