### **CHARGES FILED IN ATTEMPTED KIDNAPPING**

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a 27-year-old man accused of trying to kidnap a woman in the Cherry Creek area.

**Jeremiah Youngblood** (dob: 11-07-81) is charged with one count of *criminal attempt to commit kidnapping in the second-degree* (F5) and one count of *assault in the third-degree* (M1).

The charges allege that Youngblood grabbed a 29-year-old woman by the arm when she was jogging in the 350 block of South Jackson Street and attempted to pull the victim into his vehicle. The victim was able to get away, sustaining a minor injury. Denver police identified Youngblood as a suspect from the license plate number the victim was able to provide.

Youngblood remains in custody; his bond has been set at \$50,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 12T, on June 12, 2009 at 9 a.m. to be advised of the charges.
