BURGLARY RING BUSTED

A Denver Grand Jury has returned a 24-count indictment against five people accused of running a burglary ring that targeted high-end homes, police supply stores and gun stores.

Randy Joe Meister (dob: 03-10-85), **Jon David Alexander** (dob: 06-28-64), **Vincent Paul Gonzales** (dob: 05-04-84), **Robert Lee Loopp** (dob: 08-30-76) and **James Cash Myers** (dob: 07-06-68) are charged with violating the Colorado Organized Crime Control Act (F2) and numerous other felonies including burglary (F3), theft (F4), theft by receiving (F4), criminal mischief (F5) and possession of burglary tools (F5).

The charges allege that the five defendants associated together in a pattern of racketeering activity to steal money, jewelry, electronics, and other property including weapons and to obtain, distribute and use controlled substances.

Alexander, Gonzales, Loopp and Myers were already in custody and remain in custody on \$250,000 bond. Meister was apprehended this morning with assistance from the U.S. Marshals Service Fugitive Location Apprehension Group (FLAG) and is being held on a \$50,000 bond.

Court dates have not yet been set.
