TWO MEN WANTED IN PERJURY AND CONTEMPT CASE

Two men who pleaded guilty last month in connection with perjury and contempt of court cases have failed to appear for sentencing today and warrants have been issued for their arrest.

Kataina "Markie" Jackson-Keeling (dob: 07-01-88) and **Mario Anderson** (dob: 06-02-87) pleaded guilty in May to *accessory to perjury* (F5) and admitted that they were also in direct contempt of the Court for refusing to testify in the March 2010 Clark trial.

Both were charged in 2009 with *perjury* (F4) and *attempt to influence a public servant* (F4) because they lied to Denver police and a Denver Grand Jury that was looking into the murder of Denver Broncos player Darrent Williams.

Both defendants were scheduled to be sentenced this afternoon, but arrest warrants were issued when they failed to appear in Court.

Failing to appear for sentencing may constitute a new felony offense, violating bail bond conditions, a class 6 felony
