TWO CHARGED WITH ROBBERY, IMPERSONATING POLICE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged two people accused of robbing people by pretending to be a police officer.

Jerry John Gallegos (dob: 07-18-68) and **Angel Juarez** (dob: 07-20-71) are each charged with two counts of *robbery* (F4) and two counts of *impersonating a peace officer* (F6).

The charges allege that on May 9, 2010, Gallegos stole a man's wallet and car after he flashed a badge to stop the vehicle and asked the driver for his wallet. The charges allege a similar incident on May 17, 2010, in which Gallegos is accused of taking a victim's wallet and car keys but couldn't get the vehicle to start. The incidents occurred at 3rd Avenue at Quitman Street and Colfax Avenue at Lowell Boulevard.

Gallegos and Juarez remain in custody in the Denver County Jail; their bond is set at \$100,000. They are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 472W on Tuesday, May 25, 2010 at 10:30 a.m.
