THREE CHARGED IN ATTEMPTED ROBBERY THAT LEFT FRIEND DEAD

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged three men in connection with an attempted robbery that also left 17-year-old Montea Davis dead earlier in July.

Desean Henley (DOB: 07-12-90) is charged with one count of *manslaughter* (F4), four counts of *attempted aggravated robbery* (F4), four counts of *conspiracy to commit aggravated robbery* (F4), one count of *attempted first-degree burglary* (F4), one count of *conspiracy to commit first-degree burglary* (F4), and two *crime of violence* counts.

David Lovelace (DOB: 10-3-90) and **Steven Marquez** (DOB: 07-25-78) are each charged with four counts of *attempted aggravated robbery* (F4), four counts of *conspiracy to commit aggravated robbery* (F4), one count of *attempted first-degree burglary* (F4), one count of *conspiracy to commit first-degree burglary* (F4), and two *crime of violence* counts.

The charges allege that on July 11, 2010, Henley, Lovelace, Marquez and Davis were attempting to commit a home invasion robbery when Henley shot Montea Davis and caused his death.

Henley was arrested on an at-large warrant in Chicago, Illinois on July 26, 2010. A court date in Denver has not yet been scheduled.

Lovelace and **Marquez** remain in custody in the Denver Detention Center and are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on August 16, 2010, at 8:30 a.m. for a preliminary hearing.
