MAN CHARGED IN FATAL STABBING

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man today in connection with the death of a 26-year-old man in November.

Darold Hinojos (DOB: 11-05-77) is charged with *first-degree murder* (F1) and *first-degree burglary* (F3).

The charges allege that in the early morning hours of November 29, 2010, Hinojos engaged in an altercation at an apartment building in the 1800 block of Grove Street. The charges further allege that when a neighbor opened his apartment door to see what was happening, Hinojos stabbed him multiple times. The victim, Joey Fuller, was transported to Denver Health Medical Center where he was pronounced dead.

Hinojos remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center where he is being held without bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on December 8, 2010 at 10:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
