### **THREE CHARGED IN KIDNAPPING AND ROBBERY**

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has filed charges against three men accused of kidnapping a 32-year-old man and forcefully taking him to his residence in order to rob him.

**Semaj Magee** (dob 12-29-90) is charged with first-degree kidnapping (F2), *aggravated robbery* (F3), *first-degree burglary* (F2), *theft* (F4), *menacing* (F5), and *possession of a weapon by a previous offender* (F6).

**Royce Tiller** (dob 01-11-92) and **Monroe Thomas** (dob 12-25-74) are charged with *first-degree kidnapping* (F2), *aggravated robbery* (F3), *first-degree burglary* (F2) and *theft* (F4).

The charges allege that on May 4, 2010, the victim was approached by three males in a mini-van and ordered to get in the car at gun point. The charges further allege that the three men ordered the victim to direct them to his house and held him at gun point while they stole items of value from his residence. The victim reported that he is a medical marijuana provider, and that numerous items related to his business were stolen.

All three defendants remain in custody at the Denver County Jail; bond for Magee and Tiller is set at \$500,000 and they are scheduled to appear Wednesday, May 12, 2010 at 1:30 p.m. in Denver County Courtroom 472W to be formally advised. Thomas is scheduled to appear tomorrow, May 11, 2010, in Denver County Courtroom 2300 at 10 a.m. for his first advisement and a bond hearing.
