CHARGES FILED IN TRIPLE STABBING

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man today in connection with an incident in a fast food restaurant's drive-thru last Thursday.

Erick Munoz-Garibay (DOB: 05-21-89) is charged with three counts of *attempted murder* (F2) and three counts of *first-degree assault* (F3).

The charges allege that in the early morning hours of September 23, 2010, Munoz-Garibay approached the victims while they were waiting in their car in a drive-thru at 300 South Broadway. The charges further allege that Munoz-Garibay engaged in a confrontation with the victims, and then stabbed each of the three men.

The victims were transported to Denver Health Medical Center where they were treated for their injuries.

Munoz-Garibay remains in custody of the Denver Detention Center; his bond is set at \$500,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on October 1, 2010, to be formally advised of the charges.
