MAN CHARGED WITH IMPERSONATION AND THEFT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of portraying himself as a lawyer and stealing money from his “clients.”

Tullio Andrew Ragusin (dob: 05-23-57) was charged earlier this week with *criminal impersonation* (F6) and two counts of *theft – series* (F3 and F4).

The charges allege that Ragusin portrayed himself as an attorney and that he charged for legal services that he either never performed or performed incorrectly or incompletely. According to the arrest warrant affidavit, Ragusin is not licensed as an attorney in the United States.

Ragusin was arrested and charged on January 25, 2010. He was originally taken into custody in Douglas County and is now in custody at the Denver County Jail. His bond is set at \$100,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Court, room 472W, tomorrow, January 28, 2010 at 10:30 a.m.
