CHARGES FILED IN SEPARATE MARIJUANA ROBBERIES

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged three men today in two separate, unrelated marijuana robbery incidents.

Aris Minter (DOB: 04-02-92) and **Donjure Walker** (DOB: 12-28-89) are each charged with *aggravated robbery* (F3) and *attempted second-degree kidnapping* (F4). The charges allege that on October 16, 2010, Minter and Walker entered a marijuana dispensary in the 2000 block of South Huron Street and took cash and dried marijuana from the victim at gunpoint. The defendants were arrested a short time later in Ruby Hill Park.

Minter and **Walker** remain in custody in the Denver Detention Center; bond is set at \$50,000 each. They are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2300 on October 22, 2010, to be formally advised of the charges.

In a separate, unrelated incident **Raymond Ramirez** (DOB: 08-05-67) is charged with *robbery* (F4) and *second-degree trespassing* (M3). The charges against Ramirez allege that on October 9, 2010, he unlawfully entered the backyard of a home where marijuana for medical use was being grown and stole one of the marijuana plants. The charges further allege that as Ramirez was fleeing the property in a vehicle driven by an unknown accomplice, the driver struck a woman who lived in the home, breaking her ankle and causing significant abrasions.

Ramirez remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center; his bond is set at \$75,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2300 on October 22, 2010, to be formally advised of the charges.
