MAN WHO FIRED GUN CHARGED WITH ASSAULT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of firing a gun and aiming the weapon at police officers last weekend outside a Denver night club.

Sori Shead (dob: 11-05-88) is charged with two counts of *first degree assault (F3)* and *prohibited use of a weapon (M2)*.

The charges allege that about 2 a.m. on July 2, 2010, Shead fired gunshots into the air near 11th and Broadway and then lowered the gun aiming toward Denver police officers and a crowd of people who were in the area. The officers responded by firing their service revolvers. The officers apprehended and arrested Shead after a short foot chase that ended nearby.

Shead remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center; his bond is set at \$250,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 at 10:30 a.m., July 13, 2010 to be formally advised of the charges.
