CHARGES FILED IN ATM BURGLARIES

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged four people in connection with a series of burglaries.

Vicente Aguilar (dob: 11-23-82), **David Barela** (dob: 04-19-87), **Davey Barela** (dob: 04-19-87) and **Robert Smith** (dob: 06-21-78) are charged with multiple counts of criminal mischief, burglary and attempted theft.

The charges allege that the four were involved in numerous burglaries over the summer including an attempted theft from an ATM machine.

Aguilar, Barela and Barela have been released from custody on a \$25,000 bond. They are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on September 13, 2011 at 1:30 to be formally advised of the charges. Smith remains in custody and is scheduled to appear September 7, 2011 at 1:30pm in Denver County Courtroom 2100 to be advised.
