FINAL SENTENCE IN PARKING TICKET FORGERY

Two men who conspired to issue a fraudulent parking citation last year have been sentenced this week.

Eric Madril (dob: 04-08-80), who was found guilty of *conspiracy to commit forgery* (F6) was sentenced yesterday to one year of probation.

John Brian Culhane (dob: 09-24-66), who was found guilty of *forgery* (F5) and *conspiracy to commit forgery* (F6), was sentenced today to one year of probation.

The Court also ordered restitution of \$607.79, with joint and several liability for both defendants.

On August 19, 2009 Madril conspired with Culhane to issue a fraudulent parking citation to a driver with whom Madril had earlier been involved in a verbal confrontation.
