TWO CONVICTED IN PARKING TICKET FORGERY

Two men accused of conspiring to issue a fraudulent parking citation last year were found guilty by a Denver jury last night.

Eric Madril (dob: 04-08-80) was found guilty of *conspiracy to commit forgery* (F6) and **John Culhane** (dob: 09-24-66) was found guilty of *forgery* (F5) and *conspiracy to commit forgery* (F6).

On August 19, 2009 Madril conspired with Culhane to issue a fraudulent parking citation to a driver with whom Madril had earlier been involved in a verbal confrontation.

Madril faces probation up to a year and a half in prison when he is sentenced on November 17, 2011. Culhane faces probation up to 3 years in prison when he is sentenced on November 18, 2011.
