### **WOMAN CHARGED IN CONNECTION WITH FORBES CASE**

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a woman today who is accused of lying during the investigation into the disappearance of Kenia Monge earlier this year.

**Kerry Humphrey** (dob: 07-23-88) is charged with two counts of *attempt to influence a public servant* (F4).

The charges allege that on two separate occasions, Humphrey intentionally lied to Denver police detectives investigating the disappearance of Monge and that her deceit was intended to alter the detective's actions in the investigation.

Humphrey has been released from custody on a \$5,000 bond. She is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on October 20, 2011 at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges.

The presumptive range for sentencing on a class 4 felony is up to 6 years in prison.
