CHARGES FILED IN 2008 COLD CASE SEXUAL ASSAULT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged two men in connection with the kidnapping and sexual assault of a young woman that occurred in 2008, the result of work by Denver's Cold Case Project.

Domonique Huntington (dob: 12-28-86) and **Connie Liphford** (dob: 12-03-84) are charged with second-degree kidnapping (F2), sexual assault (F3) and unlawful sexual contact.

The charges allege that the two men offered a ride to the victim, a 26-year-old woman, but instead of taking her home they drove to an isolated area where each allegedly sexually assaulted her. They later let her out of the car in the area where she lived and she was able to walk home.

The case remained unsolved until DNA evidence collected at the time of the assault led to the identification of Huntington and Liphford as suspects. They were arrested last week and remain in custody; bond is set at \$100,000. They will appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on September 22, 2011 at 9:30 to be formally advised of the charges.
