WOMAN CHARGED IN FALSE REPORTING CASE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a woman today accused of repeatedly making false reports to the Denver police department.

Kathy Johnson (dob: 12-06-79) is charged with *attempt to influence a public servant* (F4) and six counts of *false reporting* (M3).

The charges allege that beginning on August 5, 2011 through October 4, 2011, Johnson filed a series of reports with police that she was being threatened, followed, and burglarized. The Denver Police Department's investigation led detectives to believe that she had been lying about all of the reported incidents.

Johnson has been released from custody on \$750 bond. She is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on October 21, 2011 at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
