### **WOMAN CHARGED IN KIDNAP/SEXUAL ASSAULT CASE**

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a 72-year-old woman as an accessory in connection with the kidnapping and sexual assault of an 8-year-old girl in Denver earlier this year.

**Sylvia R. Luckett** (dob: 01-14-39) is charged with one count of *Accessory to a Crime* (F4).

The charge alleges that Luckett rendered assistance to Bret Lee Thompson (dob: 03-28-84), with the intent to hinder or delay his apprehension or prosecution.

Thompson has been formally charged with *Second-degree kidnapping* (F2) and *Sexual Assault on a Child* (F4) in Denver District Court and his case remains pending.

Luckett was arrested last Friday and remains in custody in the Denver County Jail; her bond is set at \$20,000. She is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Monday, November 28, 2011 at 9:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charge.
