WOMAN IN TEEN MURDER CASE PLEADS GUILTY

A woman charged in connection with the October 2010 murder of a teenager has pleaded guilty and was sentenced today.

Jacquelyn Perea (dob: 07-24-1981) pleaded guilty to *contributing to the delinquency of a minor* (F4) and *unlawful possession of marijuana* (M1).

On October 22, 2010, Perea took 16-year-old Alicia Martinez to a party in the 4100 block of Decatur Street, and later left and returned home without her. Perea reported Martinez missing the following day. Her body was found on October 24, 2010.

Perea was sentenced today to a two-year supervised deferred judgment for the contributing to the delinquency of a minor charge. She was sentenced to two years of supervised probation for the possession of marijuana charge. If she successfully completes probation, the contributing count will be dismissed from her record. One of the conditions of the guilty plea agreement is that she cooperate with the prosecution on cases involving co-defendants.
