MAN ACCUSED OF SHOOTING AT COP IS CHARGED

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of shooting at a Denver police officer on November 6, 2012.

Larry Lynn Gomez (dob: 12-03-78) is charged today with *attempted first-degree murder* (F2) and *first-degree assault* (F3).

The charges allege that about 12:20 a.m. on November 6, 2012, Gomez fired at a Denver police officer after being stopped for a traffic violation in the 4500 block of W. 1st Avenue. Gomez was arrested on November 9, 2012, following both a vehicle and foot pursuit.

He remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center; his bond is set at \$200,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Monday, November 26, 2012, at 9:30 a.m., to be formally advised of the charges.
