MAN CHARGED WITH ATTEMPTED MURDER

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a 57-year-old man with attempted murder after an altercation with his neighbor.

Albert Gonzales (dob: 09-22-55) is charged with *criminal attempt to commit murder in the first degree (F2) and assault in the first degree (F3)*.

The charges allege Gonzales stabbed the 56-year-old victim several times with a folding knife after a verbal argument escalated into a physical altercation at their home in the 2400 block of W. 32nd Avenue. The victim was transported to a local hospital.

Gonzales remains in custody; his bond has been set at \$50,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on June 29, 2012, at 9:30 for his 2nd advisement.
