MAN CHARGED WITH ATTEMPTED MURDER IN SHOOTING

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a 27-year-old man in connection with a shooting that occurred last week near 30th Avenue and Marion Street.

Michael Jerome Guss (10-11-85) is charged with *attempted first-degree murder* (F2) and *illegal discharge of a firearm* (F5).

The charges allege that on June 26, 2012, Guss and several companions stepped in front of a car at 30th Avenue and Marion Street and that Guss fired numerous rounds from a handgun at the driver of the car. The driver wasn't hurt and was able to drive away and call police.

Guss remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center; his bond is set at \$250,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Friday, July 6, 2012, at 9:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
