CHARGES FILED IN ARSON HOMICIDE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged three men in connection with the murders of five people that occurred at Fero's Bar and Grill in Denver last week.

Dexter B. Lewis (dob: 02-16-90), **Joseph Hill** (dob: 08-11-85) and **Lynell J. Hill** (dob: 10-27-87) are each charged with five counts of *first-degree murder after deliberation* (F1), five counts of *first-degree murder – felony murder* (F1), five counts of *aggravated robbery* (F3) and one count of *first-degree arson* (F3).

The charges allege that in the early morning hours of October 17, 2012, Lewis, Hill and Hill murdered 45-year-old Kellene Fallon, 63-year-old Young Suk Fero, 29-year-old Ross Richter, 22-year-old Daria Pohl and 45-year-old Tereasa Beesley.

The defendants remain in custody in the Denver Detention Center where they are being held without bond. They are scheduled to appear in Denver District Courtroom 5H on Friday, October 26, 2012, at 8:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
