WOMAN PLEADS GUILTY IN CONNECTION WITH FORBES CASE

A woman accused of lying during the investigation into the disappearance of Kenia Monge last year has pleaded guilty in connection with the case today.

Kerry Humphrey (dob: 07-23-88) pleaded guilty to *attempt to influence a public official* (F4), 2 counts of *false reporting to authorities* (M3), and *perjury* (M1)

The charges alleged that on two separate occasions, Humphrey intentionally lied to Denver police detectives who were investigating the disappearance of Monge and that her deceit was intended to alter the investigation.

Humphrey faces a sentence of 2000 hours of community service and up to 2 years in the Denver County Jail when she appears for sentencing in Denver District Courtroom 5H on September 13, 2012, at 1:30.
