WOMAN SENTENCED IN CONNECTION WITH FORBES CASE

A woman who pleaded guilty to lying during the investigation into the disappearance of Kenia Monge last year has been sentenced in connection with the case today.

Kerry Humphrey (dob: 07-23-88) pleaded guilty earlier to *attempt to influence a public official* (F4), 2 counts of *false reporting to authorities* (M3), and *perjury* (M1).

She has been sentenced to a 4-year Deferred Judgment and 2000 hours of community service on the felony Attempt to Influence count and was sentenced to 2 years of probation including 60 days in the Denver County Jail for false reporting. She was also ordered to undergo mental health treatment, participate in a victim empathy program and maintain monitored sobriety.

In 2011, the Denver Police Department was actively investigating the disappearance of 19-year-old Kenia Monge. During that investigation, on two separate occasions, Humphrey intentionally lied to Denver police detectives with the intent of altering the investigation.
