MAN CHARGED WITH BURNING EX-WIFE'S WEDDING DRESS

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of burning his ex-wife's belongings, including her wedding dress and photos of their wedding.

Scott Kramer (dob: 01-02-1977) is charged today with one count of *second degree arson* (F4).

The charge alleges that on June 29, 2012, Kramer set fire to the victim's wedding dress, wedding pictures and skis in a trash can in the alley near his Congress Park home. The items were discovered after the victim received threatening messages.

Kramer has been released from custody on a \$50,000 bond. He is scheduled to appear for his second advisement in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on July 20, 2012 at 1:30 PM.
