WOMAN CHARGED IN HIT/RUN CASE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a woman accused of a hit and run crash that occurred last Monday.

Taylor Mathis (dob: 02-15-90) is charged with leaving the scene of an accident resulting in serious bodily injury (F5) and driving under revocation (M).

The charges allege that Mathis was driving westbound on East Colfax Avenue on Monday, January 23, 2012, at about 10:30 p.m. when her vehicle drifted into the center painted median area, striking two pedestrians.

Mathis remains in custody in the Denver County Jail; her bond is set at \$50,000. She is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on February 1, 2012 at 9:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
