MAN SENTENCED IN SOUTH DENVER ATTACK

A man who sexually assaulted a woman at the light rail station at Belleview and Quebec last year in a brutal, random attack has been given a prison sentence of 50 years to life this afternoon in Denver District Court.

Dominique Redwood (dob: 01-27-92) was convicted of *second-degree kidnapping* (F2), *sexual assault* (F2) and *aggravated robbery* (F3) in a trial earlier this year. Today he was sentenced to 16 years for the kidnapping, 24 years to life for the sexual assault, and 10 years for the aggravated robbery, running consecutively. He was also sentenced to an additional 8 years for an unrelated prior case.

The attack occurred as the victim, a 23-year-old woman, was leaving the light rail station on Sunday, March 6, 2011 at about 8:30 a.m. Redwood walked up behind her, robbed her at knifepoint of her wallet and cell phone, and then forced her into an elevator where he sexually assaulted her. With the help of RTD security officers, detectives with the Denver Police Department's Sex Crimes Unit were able to identify Redwood as a suspect and arrested him just a few days later.

The case was prosecuted by Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey and Deputy District Attorney Maggie Conboy.
