MAN CHARGED IN FATAL HIT/RUN

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a 30-year-old man accused in a fatal hit/run crash last week on South Parker Road.

Jim Tillmon (dob: 08-31-82) is charged with *vehicular homicide* (F4) and *leaving the scene of an accident resulting in death* (F3).

On December 6, 2012, at about 6 p.m., the victim, 61-year-old Zewde Ali, was standing in the center median in the 1000 block of South Parker Road when she was struck by a vehicle. The charges allege that Tillmon was driving the vehicle that hit her and that he fled the scene without providing aid or reporting the crash.

Tillmon was arrested on December 8, 2012 and remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center; his bond is set at \$250,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on December 14, 2012 at 9:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
