WOMAN SENTENCED FOR DAMAGING CLYFFORD STILL PAINTING

A woman accused of damaging a painting at the Clyfford Still Museum last December has pleaded guilty and been sentenced in the case.

Carmen Tisch (dob: 03-07-75) pleaded guilty to *criminal mischief* (F4) on May 17, 2012 and went to immediate sentencing. She was sentenced to 2 years of mental health probation and was ordered to undergo alcohol treatment as a condition of probation. A restitution hearing may still be scheduled.

On December 29, 2011, at about 3:30 p.m., Tisch was at the museum at 1250 Bannock Street in Denver when she approached a painting and proceeded to scratch, hit and lean against the painting.
