MAN CHARGED WITH MURDER IN GIRLFRIEND'S DEATH

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of shooting and killing 20-year-old Natasha Carrillo on August 10, 2012.

Robert Trujillo (dob: 06-01-82) is charged today with *first-degree murder* (F1).

The charge alleges that on Friday afternoon August 10, 2012, Trujillo shot and killed Carrillo in her home in the 1400 block of Knox Court. Trujillo, a former boyfriend, was arrested two days later without incident.

He remains in custody in the Denver Detention Center where he is being held without bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on August 22, 2012, at 9:30 a.m., to be formally advised of the charge.
