TWO NEIGHBORS CHARGED IN ASSAULT INCIDENT

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of assaulting neighbors in his apartment complex. A woman involved in the incident has also been charged.

Robert “Bob” Walter (dob: 09-13-59) is charged with *burglary* (F3), two counts of *third-degree assault* (M1), *assault of an at-risk victim* (F6), and *child abuse* (M1).

Alice Bozeman (dob: 08-01-46), is charged with *assault on a peace officer* (F4) and *obstructing a peace officer* (M2).

On June 11, 2012, Denver Police responded to a neighborhood dispute call in the 1500 block of Hooker Street. The charges allege that Walter went into a neighboring apartment, wearing only boxer shorts and carrying an alcoholic beverage, and assaulted several residents including a six-month-old baby. The charges further allege that Bozeman assaulted an officer when police tried to arrest Walter.

Walter and Bozeman both remain in custody. Walter’s bond is set at \$50,000; Bozeman’s bond is set at \$5,000. They are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on June 19, 2012, at 9:30 AM to be formally advised of the charges.
