### **CHARGES FILED IN DETENTION CENTER ESCAPE**

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man accused of escaping from the Denver Detention Center and has also charged a sheriff's deputy accused of helping him.

**Felix Trujillo** (dob: 02-19-89) is charged with one count of *escape* (F3).

**Matthew Andrews** (dob: 12-26-76) is charged with one count of *aiding escape* (F3).

The charges allege that on April 7, 2013, at about 7 p.m., Andrews, who was working at the detention center, assisted Trujillo, who was being held as an inmate, to escape from custody.

Andrews has been released from custody on a \$10,000 and is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on April 22, 2013, at 1:30 p.m. to be advised of the charge against him. Trujillo, who was taken into custody on April 10, 2013, remains in custody. His bond is set at \$100,000. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on April 19, 2013, at 9:30 a.m. to be advised of the escape charge.
