19-YEAR OLD CHARGED WITH ATTEMPTED SEXUAL ASSAULT AT SCHOOL

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a 19-year-old high school student in connection with an assault on another student at a local high school.

Paris Bonds (dob: 11-13-93) was charged yesterday with sexual contact-no consent (F4), attempted sexual assault (F5) and harassment (M3) in connection with an incident that took place at Montbello High School earlier this year.

The charges allege that Bonds approached a female victim in the band room, touched her inappropriately and attempted to sexually assault her. The incident came to light after the victim disclosed what had happened to a therapist.

Bonds was arrested last Friday and remains in custody on a \$50,000 bond. He is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 tomorrow, May 17, 2013, at 9:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.

Investigators are concerned there could be additional victims; anyone with information should call Denver police at 720-913-6040.
