SIBLINGS CHARGED IN SERIES OF THEFTS

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a man and a woman accused in connection with a series of burglaries.

Charles Darrow (dob: 03-07-68) and **Valorie Darrow** (dob: 04-30-69) are charged with multiple counts of *second -degree burglary* (F4) and multiple *Pawnbroker's Act Violations* (F6).

The charges allege that from May 31, 2013 to June 20, 2013, the Darrows broke into storage sheds at homes and churches. The charges further allege that stolen items were later pawned. The pair is charged with a combined total of 17 counts. The investigation is still ongoing; additional charges may be filed.

Charles and Valorie Darrow remain in custody. Bond is set at \$5,000 and \$2,000 respectively. The Darrows are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on July 1, 2013 at 9:30 a.m. for their second advisement.
