TWO CHARGED AS AN ACCESSORY IN FATAL HIT/RUN CRASH

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged two more people in connection with a fatal hit/run crash that occurred last week at 13th Avenue and Kalamath Street.

Kelly Carey-Morehead (dob: 12-09-69) and **Kiki Douglas** (dob: 05-29-82) are both charged with being an accessory to crime (F5) and false reporting to authorities (M3).

The charges allege that they provided false identifying information and rendered other assistance to **Latoya Nelson** (dob: 10-30-83) following a fatal hit/run crash on March 27, 2013, that claimed the life of 85-year-old Charlie Herrera.

Nelson is accused of causing the fatal crash and fleeing from the scene. She was charged earlier with *vehicular homicide* (F4), *leaving the scene of an accident resulting in death* (F3), *criminal impersonation* (F6) and *third-degree assault* (M1).

Douglas and Carey-Morehead have been released from custody and are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on April 16, 2013, at 1:30 p.m. to be formally advised of the charges. Nelson remains in custody and is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on April 22, 2013, at 8:30 a.m. for a preliminary hearing.
