WOMAN CHARGED IN CAR FIRE

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged a woman accused of setting fire to a rental car in front of the Webb Municipal Building last week.

Anastasia Gordeeva (dob: 10-07-74) is charged with one count of second-degree arson (F4).

The charge alleges that she drove a rental car up onto a courtyard area next to the Webb Building, then set fire to the car by igniting a blanket in the back seat.

Gordeeva remains in custody in the Denver County Jail; her bond is set at \$5,000. She is scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 on Friday, November 15, 2013, at 9:30 a.m. to be advised of the charge.
