THREE CHARGED IN DISPENSARY ROBBERY

Denver District Attorney Mitch Morrissey has formally charged three people in connection with the armed robbery of a medical marijuana dispensary that occurred two weeks ago. A fourth person has been arrested and his charges are pending.

Khamis Horn (dob: 01-13-87), **James Hughes** (dob: 11-06-92) and **Lynn Shangreaux** (dob: 02-20-95) are each charged with *first-degree kidnapping* (F2) and two counts of *aggravated robbery* (F3). Christopher Bletson (dob: 08-07-89) has been arrested but not yet formally charged in the case.

On August 22, 2013, the Denver Police Department responded to a report of a robbery in progress at a medical marijuana dispensary in the 4400 block of Zenobia Street. The charges allege that Horn, Hughes and Bletson robbed the dispensary at gunpoint and that Shangreaux drove a get-away car from the scene.

The defendants remain in custody; bond is set at \$50,000. They are scheduled to appear in Denver County Courtroom 2100 tomorrow, September 5, 2013, at 9:30 a.m. to be formally advised of the charges.
